**OUT WITH THE OLD****Ergonom 'B' Mechanism**

It has been on the cards for a little while now but the Ergonom 'B' tilting mechanism has officially been discontinued. Limited stocks of these mechanisms are available but will most likely be held back for a limited period of time so as to honour any failures that occur during existing warranty periods.

If you have an immediate requirement for a chair fitted with the Ergonom B mechanism then it may be possible for us to complete your order. However, we strongly advise that you check with us first before placing your orders!

We suggest that as an alternative you could consider the SPS models or the new and improved Type 11 & 12 models - Further details on this can be found below.

There is a new dynamic mechanism available for the Xenium seating range. XENIUM FREEWORK has been designed and developed to offer continuous flexibility to your working posture.

Lateral movement of the mechanism means that the chair flows and moves as you do. Reaching for that pedestal drawer? Accessing that file at the side of you? Standard chair mechanisms will leave your back unsupported as you make these everyday changes to your posture. The FREEWORK mechanism does no such thing and will follow the change in your body movement as you make it.

**RINGING THE CHANGES****DuoBack® Type 11 & 12**

Our most popular DuoBack® chairs have undergone a facelift for Spring 2010. New and improved 3-Dimensional armrests are now available as a standard. These armrests offer a greater range of width adjustability than the original OPU armrests. The improved range of width adjustment means that the Type 11 & 12 DuoBack® will comfortably cater for the narrowest of elbow to elbow measurements.

As of March 15 all Type 11 & 12 chairs will be provided with the new armrest as standard.

A further addition is the option of a forward seat tilt mechanism. Hurray! This new feature will allow you to adjust the seat in angle independently of the back rake of the chair.

We will be holding stocks of the Type 11 with armrests and seat tilt mechanism which will be finished in Camira's Xtreme Plus Havana (Black).

We anticipate delivery of these stock chairs at the end of March.
